A PROFESSION WITH A BRIGHT FUTURE

Becoming a therapist can be a goal for many, but there are many other ways to use your training in your professional life. EDUCATE AND SUPPORT

CONSULTATION:

A therapist, naturopath, homeopath or nutritionist can choose to work independently or with a group of other therapists with complementary skills. They can also be an employee in an organization specialized in health and fitness or support services, for example in cure centers.

HEALTH AND RESEARCH

For many medical, paramedical, and social professionals, the naturopathic approach offers a way to grow their practice. They draw new clients by offering a holistic view, rather than just a symptom based approach.



SPORTS CLUBS, REJUVENATION CENTERS, AND THALASSOTHERAPY CENTERS:

Here the therapist offers a new and complementary service to those already available. The emphasis is on prevention and education. Any number of positions can be envisioned, from accompaniment to facilities management.

TRANSMIT & SHARE

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND ANIMATION

Self-employed, employee of an organization or business, this career path can lead you to many roles and opportunities. From education and training of the public or scholars, professionals (restaurant industry, nursery staff, nursing home staff, etc.) to occasional animation, regular teaching, tutoring, and the arrangement of internships or short stays.

COMMUNICATION AND SPECIALIZED JOURNALISM

The increased interest in alternative medicine has brought opportunities to manage columns on health, well being, nutrition, etc. Similar opportunities are possible in the field of communications, in the private or public sector, seeing as environment and health often constitute major issues.

PROMOTE AND SELL

ADVERSITISING AND MARKETING

New companies are being created or reoriented to provide the public with alternative health care. Existing companies may refocus themselves on this expanded interest. There is a need for knowledgeable contributors and consultants to help them succeed, given that it goes beyond the commercial aspect.

EVENTS

Seminars, expos, organic fairs, and eco-festivals are growing in numbers and require personnel with knowledge to run them.

SALES AND STORE MANAGEMENT

Natural health care or well being is seeing an expansion in its sales related activities. Organic and natural health care stores, book stores and laboratories are on the rise. The array of treatments and products they offer can be very overwhelming to the untrained customer. Stores want staff that is knowledgeable in alternative medicine to help their customers make educated choices. Your education will make you effective in sales and health store management.



DISTANCE LEARNING

BALANCING QUALITY & FLEXIBILITY

The Alternative Medicine College of Canada is proud to offer distance learning programs. This allows ambitious students to get the education they want, no matter where they live. FUNDAMENTAL OBJECTIVES OF OUR PROGRAM

Our programs satisfy three main objectives in alternative medicine.

- Prevention through healthy lifestyle programs, based on weight control, dietary balance, correcting nutritional deficiencies, detoxification, revitalization, exercise, and stress management.

ESSENTIAL SKILLS TO DEVELOP

Distance learning is suitable for adults who wish to develop certain qualities :

CHOOSE... NATUROPATHY

In addition to the Natural Health Practitioner curriculum, the Naturopath receives specialized training in naturopathy. This makes it possible for them to carry out in depth treatments of chronic illness and functional problems.

ND900 PROGRAM

This specialization contains three courses dedicated to care techniques including Phytoenergetics (using plants according to the biological terrain), Oligotherapy (minerals), and Aromatherapy (essential oils). It also includes a course on the Semiology of the biological terrain, used to determine the particular reactive type of an individual. Finally, students will have to complete clinical case studies to get hands-on experience and apply what they have learned.

In addition to the Natural Health Practitioner curriculum, the Homeopath receives specialized training in homeopathy.

HO600 PROGRAM

Homeopaths are able to implement intensive treatments for chronic diseases and all levels of functional problems. This specialization contains three courses dedicated to homeopathic medicine. Students will use medical knowledge and develop their research abilities. A fourth course teaches students to use certain tools, such as drainage, organotherapy, vaccine strains, biochemical salts, etc. Finally, a fifth course is focused on clinical study cases to allow students to get hands-on experience.

POST GRADUATE PROGRAMS



CHOOSE... POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA

In addition to their training in naturopathy, homeopathy or bio-energetics, the practitioner develops an expertise in the clinical field. Throughout courses and papers, adding up to 30 credits, students can develop the necessary mental reflexes for a good professional practice. This program is also suitable for practicing professionals in need of a post graduate diploma.

1011, 1012, 1013 PROGRAMS

To register for these modules, students must have completed a diploma in naturopathy, homeopathy, bio-energetics, or have obtained a certification considered to be equivalent by the AMCC. The diploma will be delivered upon presentation of a one-year active practice confirmation.

ELEVATE YOUR PRACTICE

In addition to clinical case studies, the curriculum involves practical coaching. The Client-Practitioner Relationship course teaches the practitioner how to foster better relationships with clients, leading to better treatment plans. Learn how to factor personality, client needs, and client's capacity to comply, when designing a treatment plan. The Developing a Professional Practice course focuses on legal considerations, office management, aspects of marketing, and how to generate income. An Internship, which must be completed under the supervision of an active practitioner, completes the curriculum.

PURSuing A TOPIC OF INTEREST

The Post Graduate Diploma program allows an in-depth investigation into student's topic of interest, which can lead to a professional direction. Based on the option, the research paper encourages students to reflect on and apply what they have learned. The thesis paper is a practical exercise that also shows a student's individual expression. It encourages students to reflect on and apply what they have learned.

EQUIVALENCE AND EXEMPTIONS

If you have already taken courses in another institution and now wish to obtain a diploma from the Alternative Medicine College of Canada, choose our Equivalence Program. A list of available equivalences is given on the following page.



EQUIVALENCE REQUEST

This request concerns only programs and modules. To request equivalence, you must have taken all of the courses in the chosen level or program. Your hours of study per credit must be equivalent to the College's required hours per credit in the chosen field. The College allows you to take the missing courses, as long as these do not represent more than 30% of the courses in the chosen program. To submit an equivalence request you must fill in the designated form provided by the AMCC, pay the administrative fees by sending a first payment along with your request and justificative documents.

REQUEST PROCEDURE FOR PROGRAMS AND MODULES

Please state the title and number of the diploma. Verify that you have an equivalent for each course by consulting the course descriptions in the program/ module of your choice. You can find description of content for each on our website. Fill in the Equivalence Request Form and choose one of the equivalences. Fill in the requested information on both forms (Online Admission Form and Equivalence Request Form). Write a presentation letter stating your professional or scholastic experience and your projects or objectives. EXEMPTIONS

You can request and obtain an exam exemption for one or more courses taken in another institution.

You can choose to receive course material with no obligation to take the exam.

If you do not wish to receive the course materials, you can get a tuition reduction, equivalent to the price of the exempted courses.

For course exemption requests (three courses maximum), you must fill the Admission Form, send all supporting documents and pay the administrative fees for the exemption requested.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

Once your Registration Confirmation is received, you have ten days to cancel or modify your registration. After this period, you will receive a message from your tutor: your registration is activated and your first course materials will be sent to you.
